Upcoming Programs and Workshops

June 28 - Annual Picnic - special time 6 pm.

The guild's Annual Picnic will be held Thursday, June 28, 2018, at the Pennsdale United Methodist Church. The guild will provide picnic entree, the drinks and the tableware. Members should bring a dish to pass. Let us try your favorite picnic goodies, salads, desserts, veggies, whatever.

At our **July 26, 2018** meeting as we will be exploring a barn quilt trail presentation by the author of two books, Suzi Parron at 7PM at Trinity United Methodist Church in Pennsdale PA. She has published the books along with Donna Sue Groves who started putting quilts on barns in 2001 in Adams County, Ohio. These quilts are now in more than 40 states and Canada. There are a few trails in our local area of Muncy and Wyalusing PA.

If you would like more information about Suzi or how to get a quilt trail started, there is a very nice article in American Patchwork & Quilting - Issue 152 for June 2018 or purchase either of her books - *Barn Quilts & the American Trail Movement* published February 2012 or *Following the Barn Quilt Trail* published April 2016.

Suzi will also be offering a workshop to paint a 2' X 2' wooden quilt that could adorn your property for just \$45 (guild members) and if you are a non-guild member, the price will be \$50. This fee must be paid by June 28 to keep your place. You could choose your own pattern or use one of hers. She provides a primed board, paint and brushes.

September 28, 2018 - FRIDAY change in date, monthly meeting. Three certified instructors of Deb Tucker's Design Rulers, Heidi Chase, Kathy Webb and Ellen Cicak, owners of Running With Scissors Quilters of Owego, NY and Doylestown, PA, will present a demonstration of various rulers. September 29, 2018 - Saturday Workshop of "Love Links" quilt pattern made with interlocking chevrons. A difficult looking design is made easy using the flying geese "Wing Clipper" ruler, making this a quick and easy quilt to master. The cost of the workshop is \$15.00 per member plus the pattern fee. A wing clipper ruler is required and can be purchase before the workshop or from the instructors. 10am to 3 pm. A materials list will be distributed. Sign up begins at the July meeting. MEETING RECAP

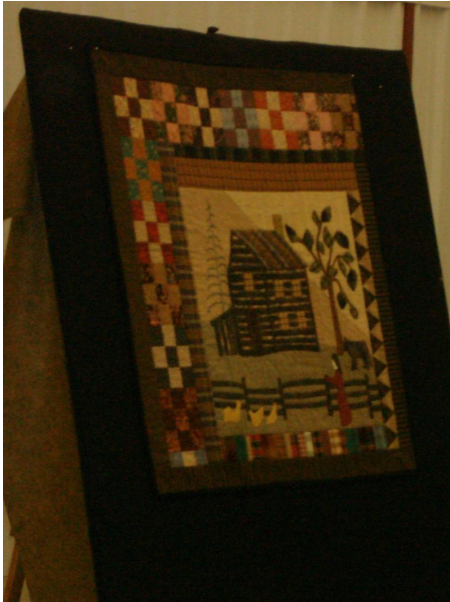
May meeting with Wendy Etzel

While Wendy has decided to discontinue teaching quilt making, she is sharing her works at a first ever Quilt Show, named "Kite Revue" on October 6, 7, 8, 2018, at the Plunketts Creek Firehall (along Rt 87).
