

"Jelly In the Cabin" by Carol Brown

You will need 1 Jelly Roll by
MODA or 40 asst strips cut
 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by the width of the fabric.

For speed in cutting, leave
strip folded in $\frac{1}{2}$ lengthwise.
Trim selvage edges. Cut twice
@ $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (yields 4 squares). Cut twice
@ $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (yields 4 rectangles $2\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$).
Cut once @ $6\frac{1}{2}$ " (yields 2 rectangles
@ $2\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$). Repeat with ALL
40 strips.

From ONE fabric, you will need
1- $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square, 2- $2\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ Rectangles,
and 1- $2\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ Rectangle. For
the center, you will use a $2\frac{1}{2}$ "
square of another fabric.

Construct like "Log Cabin" circling
the center square. Diagram B.

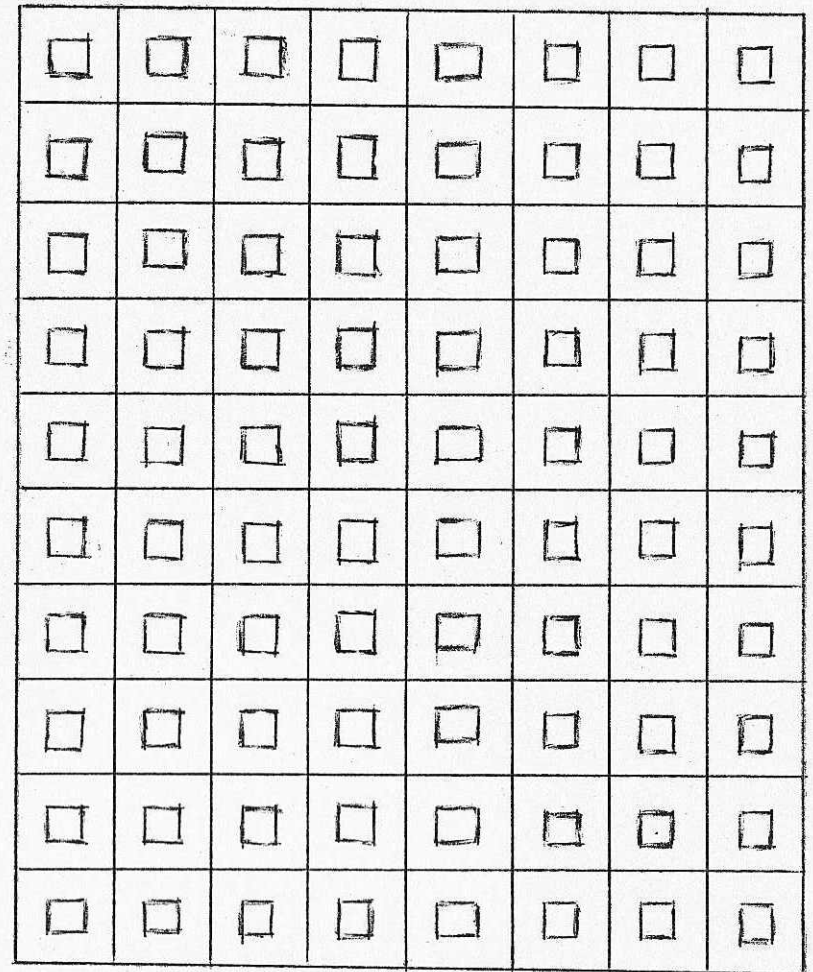


Diagram B
