PINT SIZE TABLE RUNNER — April —



PLEASE NOTE.....

All seams are 1/4"

WOF = Width of Fabric

RST = Right Sides Together

REQUIRED MATERIALS....

- $8" \times 15"$ dusty pink with flowers for **HST** (**Fabric A**)
- 7" × WOF cream floral for **HST** and **strip piecing** (**Fabric B**)
- 4" × 21" teal ditsy for **strip piecing** (**Fabric C**)
- 3½" × 14" dark red with flowers for **block centers** and **cornerstone** (Fabric D)
- 4" × 14" orange pink stripe for sashing (Fabric E)
- 14" × 14" cream with orange streaks for **appliqué** backgrounds (Fabric F)
- 7" × WOF teal mottled for **binding** (**Fabric G**)
- 27" × 21" for **backing**
- various scraps for appliqué
- fusible webbing

CUT FABRICS.....

From dusty pink with flowers (Fabric A), cut:

 (8) 3" × 3" squares for HST
 OR, if using Star Singles 2" Half Square Triangle Papers, (2) 6½" × 6½" squares

From cream floral (Fabric B), cut:

• (8) 3" × 3" squares for **HST OR,** if using Star Singles 2" Half Square Triangle Papers, (2) 6½" × 6½" squares

• (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " × 21" for strip piecing

From teal ditsy (Fabric C), cut:

• (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " × 21" for strip piecing

From dark red with flowers (Fabric D), cut:

- (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " × $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for **block centers**
- (1) $1" \times 1"$ square for **cornerstone**

From orange pink stripe (Fabric E), cut:

• (4) $1'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ for sashing


From cream with orange streaks (**Fabric F**)

Noting orientation of streaks, cut:

• (2) 5½" × 13" rectangles for appliqué backgrounds

From teal mottled (Fabric G), cut:

• (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips for **binding**



Finishes to: $13" \times 23"$

Half Square Triangles_

If using Star Singles 2" Half Square Triangle Paper: Use (2) papers, (2) 6½" × 6½" Fabric A squares, and (2) 6½" × 6½" Fabric B squares (fabric squares will be slightly larger than the papers). Follow instructions included with papers to make a total of (16) A/B HST and skip ahead to * Strip Piecing.

STEP 1: On the back of (1) $3" \times 3"$ B square, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner.

STEP 2: Layer this square and (1) $3" \times 3"$ A square, RST, making sure to line up the edges.


STEP 3: Sew 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line.

STEP 4: Cut on the drawn line. Press toward Fabric A.

STEP 5: You will now have two A/B units.

STEP 6: Repeat Steps 1-5 to make a total of (16) A/B units.

IMPORTANT: Trim each HST to $2\frac{1}{2}$ " × $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".



*STRIP PIECING_____

Sew (1) Fabric B strip to (1) Fabric C strip. Press open.

Cut strip sets into 2½" segments.

Repeat to make a total of (16) units. Each unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " × $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".




FLOWER BLOCKS_____

Arrange units as shown. Sew together into rows. Press toward strip pieced units.

Sew rows together. Press away from block center.

Block should measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ " × $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Make a total of (4) Flower Blocks.



APPLIQUÉ.


NOTE: With the exception of the umbrella handle and bow, the appliqué design is symmetrical, so there is no need for a reverse diagram when tracing shapes for fusible appliqué. (Reversed umbrella handle and bow shapes are provided for tracing.) Gently peel fusible paper from the back of each shape. Refer to Assembly Diagram to arrange shapes on background fabric. Appliqué in place using the method and stitch of your choice.



Appliqué - Make (2)

ASSEMBLE TABLE RUNNER_____

Arrange blocks as shown. Sew **sashing** strip between two blocks; press toward sashing. Sew sashing strips to each side of **cornerstone**; press toward sashing. Sew pieced blocks and sashing unit together; press toward sashing unit. Sew one appliqué unit to each end as shown; press toward pieced blocks.



FINISH TABLE RUNNER__.

Layer top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired.

Piece **binding** into one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise, wrong sides together, and press. Line up raw edges of the binding with the raw edge of the table runner. Sew binding to the front side of the table runner, starting at any side. Turn the binding over and hand stitch to the back of the table runner.

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Assembly Diagram

With the exception of the umbrella handle (2) and bow (4 through 8), design is symmetrical; diagram can be used for tracing and for placement

seam allowance 19 Align bullseye marks \oplus on page 1 with bullseye marks \oplus on page 2, then tape pages together
