# PINT SIZE TABLE RUNNER -March -

### PLEASE NOTE\_\_\_\_\_

All seams are ¼" WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together

# REQUIRED MATERIALS

- 14" × WOF cream metallic ombre for **piecing** and **appliqué backgrounds**
- 6" × 21" black with green vines for **piecing**
- 6" × 21" green vines for **piecing**
- 6" × 14" dark green shamrocks for **piecing**
- 4" × 14" gold metallic for **piecing**
- 4" × 14" green streaks for sashing
- 7" × WOF black for **binding**
- 27" × 21" for **backing**
- various scraps for appliqué
- fusible webbing

# CUT FABRICS

#### From cream metallic ombre, fussy cut:

- (2) 5<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 13" rectangles for **appliqué backgrounds** We fussy cut our backgrounds from the ends nearest the selvages, where the metallic confetti is most dense
- (4) 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 14" strips for **4-patch units**
- (32)  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ×  $1\frac{1}{2}$  squares for clover leaf units

### From **black with green vines**, cut:

• (16)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for clover leaf units

#### From green vines, cut:

• (3) 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 14" strips for **4-patch units** 

### From dark green shamrocks, cut:

• (2) 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 14" strips for **4-patch units** 

### From gold metallic, cut:


- (1) 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 14" strips for **4-patch units**
- (1)  $1" \times 1"$  square for **cornerstone**

#### From green streaks, cut:

• (4)  $1" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$  rectangles for **sashing** 

### From **black solid**, cut:

• (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips for **binding** 



Finishes to: 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 22<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"

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# 4-PATCH UNITS\_\_\_

Sew (1) cream metallic ombre  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " × 14" strip to (1) green vines  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " × 14" strip. Press toward green.

Cut strip set into 1½" segments. Each segment should measure 1½"  $\times$  2½".

Repeat with remaining  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " × 14" strips to make the units as shown at right:

Refer to the images (*right*) to arrange units into a 4-Patch. Sew units together in rows, pressing seams toward green. Sew rows together, pressing seams open. Repeat to make a total of (20) 4-Patch units. Each 4-Patch unit should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".

# CLOVER LEAF UNITS

**STEP 1:** On the back of each  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " cream square, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Place (1) cream square in the upper left corner of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " black with green vines square, RST, noting the direction of the diagonal.

**<u>STEP 2</u>**: Sew on the drawn line, and trim seam allowance to <sup>1</sup>/4". Press toward cream.

**<u>STEP 3</u>**: Place another cream square in the upper right corner of the same black square, RST, noting the direction of the diagonal.

<u>STEP 4:</u> Sew on the drawn line, and trim seam allowance to <sup>1</sup>/4". Press toward cream.

Repeat to make a total of (16) Clover Leaf units. Each unit should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".

# Lucky Irish Chain Blocks.....


Use (5) 4-Patch units and (4) Clover Leaf units per block.

Arrange units as shown. Sew together into rows. Press away from 4-Patch units.

Sew rows together. Press away from block center.

Block should measure  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Make a total of (4) Lucky Irish Chain Blocks.



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# Appliqué

NOTE: With the exception of the heap o' gold, the appliqué design is symmetrical, so there is no need for a reverse diagram when tracing shapes for fusible appliqué. (*Reversed heap o' gold shape is provided for tracing.*)

Gently peel fusible paper from the back of each shape. Refer to Assembly Diagram to arrange shapes on background fabric.


Appliqué in place using the method and stitch of your choice.

### Assemble Table Runner\_\_\_\_\_

Arrange blocks as shown. Sew **sashing** strip between two blocks; press toward sashing. Sew sashing strips to each side of **cornerstone**; press toward sashing. Sew pieced blocks and sashing unit together; press toward sashing unit. Sew one appliqué unit to each end as shown; press toward pieced blocks.



# Finish Table Runner

Layer top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired.

Piece **binding** into one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise, wrong sides together, and press. Line up raw edges of the binding with the raw edge of the table runner. Sew binding to the front side of the table runner, starting at any side. Turn the binding over and hand stitch to the back of the table runner.

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




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# **Assembly Diagram**


With the exception of the Heap o' Gold (1), all shapes are symmetrical; diagram can be used for tracing and for placement



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
