PLEASE NOTE.....

All seams are ¼"
WOF = Width of Fabric
RST = Right Sides Together

REQUIRED MATERIALS....

- $4" \times 10"$ lavender floral sprigs for **HST** (**Fabric A**)
- 4" × 10" dark purple floral sprigs for **HST** and **cornerstone** (**Fabric B**)
- 8" × 14" purple tonal floral for basket (Fabric C)
- ½ yard cream with tan dot for piecing and appliqué backgrounds (Fabric D)
- $4" \times 14"$ green tonal flower groups for **sashing** (**Fabric E**)
- 7" × WOF green texture for **binding** (**Fabric F**)
- 27" × 21" for **backing**
- various scraps for appliqué
- fusible webbing

CUT FABRICS_____

From lavender floral sprigs (Fabric A), cut:

• (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " × $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for **HST**

From dark purple floral sprigs (Fabric B), cut:

- (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " × $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for **HST**
- (1) $1" \times 1"$ square for **cornerstone**

From purple tonal floral (Fabric C), cut:

- (4) 3½" × 3½" squares cut in half diagonally ✓ for **basket**
- (4) 1½" × 2½" rectangles for **basket base right**
- (4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " × $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for **basket base left**

From cream with scattered tan dot (Fabric D), cut:

- (2) 57/8" × 57/8" squares cut in half diagonally ☐ for **basket handle appliqué**
- (2) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " × 13" rectangles for **appliqué background**
- (8) 4½" × 1½" rectangles for **beside basket**
- (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " × $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for **below basket**

From green tonal flower groups (Fabric E), cut:

• (4) $1'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles for **sashing**

From green texture (**Fabric F**), cut:

• (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips for **binding**



Finishes to: $13" \times 23"$




Applioué_

NOTE: With the exception of the center flower and leaves, the appliqué design is symmetrical, so there is no need for a reverse diagram when tracing shapes for fusible appliqué. (Reversed center flower and leaves shapes are provided for tracing.)

Gently peel fusible paper from the back of each shape. Refer to Assembly Diagram to arrange shapes on basket appliqué triangles and appliqué background fabric.

Appliqué in place using the method and stitch of your choice.





Appliqué - Make (2)

Half Square Triangles.

STEP 1: On the back of (1) A square, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner.

STEP 2: Layer this square and (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " × $3\frac{1}{2}$ " B square, RST, making sure to line up the edges.

STEP 3: Sew 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line.

STEP 4: Cut on the drawn line. Press open.

STEP 5: You will now have two A/B units.

STEP 6: Repeat Steps 1-5 to make a total of (4) A/B units.

IMPORTANT: Trim each HST to 3" × 3".











Step 5 Make (4)

BASKET BLOCKS_____


STEP 1: Sew C triangles to top and left side of A/B HST, aligning right angles with HST. Press open.

STEP 2: Align 45° lines on ruler (highlighted in cyan) with HST seams, and trim diagonal seam allowance to 1/4" past intersection.

STEP 3: Place Basket Handle Appliqué on pieced unit, RST. Because both units are cut on the bias, be careful not to stretch fabric as you sew them together along diagonal. Press open. Unit should measure $5\frac{1}{2}$ " × $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".

STEP 4: Sew Fabric C basket base left square to the end of a Fabric D beside basket rectangle. Press open.

STEP 5: Sew basket base left unit to bottom of basket unit, noting orientation. Press toward basket base unit.

STEP 6: Sew Fabric C basket base right rectangle to the end of a Fabric D beside basket rectangle. Press open.

STEP 7: Sew basket base right unit to right side of basket unit, noting orientation. Press toward basket base right unit.


STEP 8: Place (1) D 2½" × 2½" **below basket** square in corner, RST, as shown. Pin carefully at corners.

STEP 9: Turn block over and draw a 45° line from corner to corner, making sure drawn line intersects the basket point. Pin well around drawn line. Sew on drawn line.

STEP 10: Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press toward D.


Repeat to make a total of (4) Basket Blocks. Each block should measure 6½" × 6½".









Assemble Table Runner.....

Arrange blocks as shown. Sew sashing strip between two blocks; press toward sashing. Sew sashing strips to each side of cornerstone; press toward sashing. Sew pieced blocks and sashing unit together; press toward sashing unit. Sew one appliqué unit to each end as shown; press toward pieced blocks.



FINISH TABLE RUNNER

Layer top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired.

Piece binding into one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise, wrong sides together, and press. Line up raw edges of the binding with the raw edge of the table runner. Sew binding to the front side of the table runner, starting at any side. Turn the binding over and hand stitch to the back of the table runner.




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Assembly Diagram

With the exception of the center flower (5) and leaves (3 and 4), all shapes are symmetrical; diagram can be used for tracing and for placement






