PLEASE NOTE

All seams are ¼"

WOF = Width of Fabric

RST = Right Sides Together

REQUIRED MATERIALS

- 12" × WOF cream red scattered dot for **appliqué backgrounds, spool "B", spool "D", and cornerstone**
- 5" × 14" gold grid for **spool "A"**
- 5" × 14" green scattered squares for **spool "A"**
- 5" × 14" red ditsy for **spool "A"**
- 5" × 14" dark pink Xs for **spool "A"**
- 6" × 7" yellow gingham for **spool "C"**
- 6" × 7" light green Xs for **spool "C"**
- 6" × 7" red gingham for **spool "C"**
- 6" × 7" pink lattice for **spool "C"**
- 4" × 14" aqua floral stripe for **sashing**
- 7" × WOF aqua solid for **binding**
- 27" × 21" for **backing**
- various scraps for appliqué
- fusible webbing

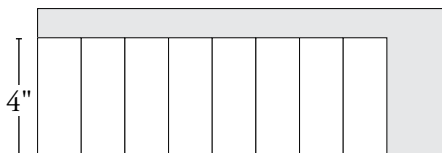
CUT FABRICS

From cream red scattered dot, cut:

- (2) 5½" × 13" rectangles for **appliqué backgrounds**
- (32) 1½" × 2" rectangles for **spool "D"**
- (64) 1½" × 1½" squares for **spool "B"**
- (1) 1" × 1" square for **cornerstone**

From **each** of four dark colors, cut:

- (8) 4" × 1½" for **spool "A"**



From **each** of four light colors, cut:

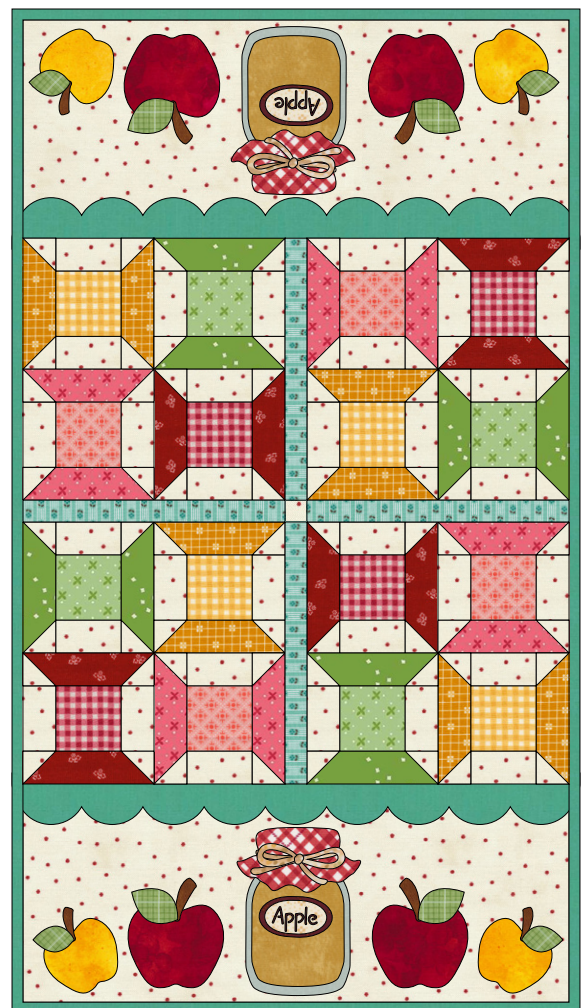
- (4) 2" × 2" for **spool "C"**

From aqua floral stripe, cut:

- (4) 1" × 6½" rectangles for **sashing**

From aqua solid, cut:

- (2) 2½" × WOF for **binding**



Finishes to: 13" × 23"

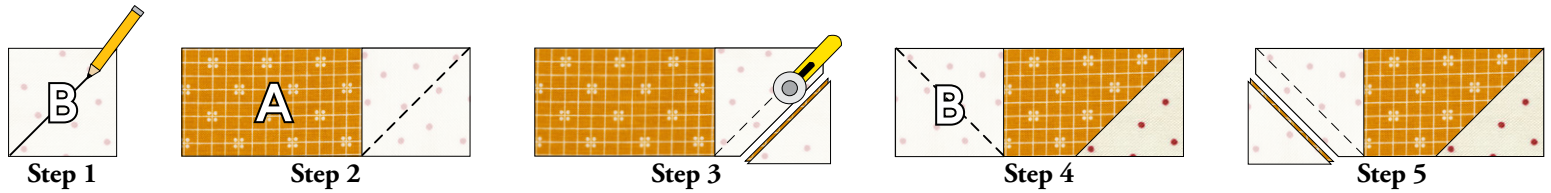

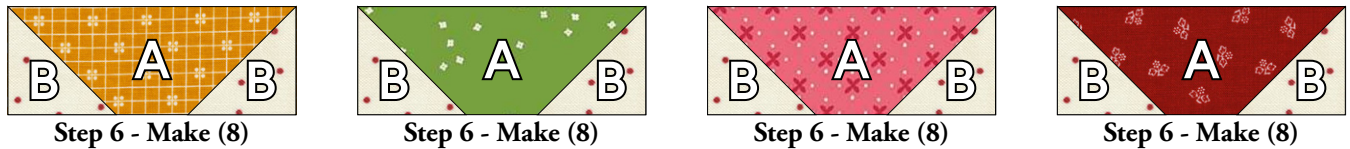

SPOOL BLOCKS

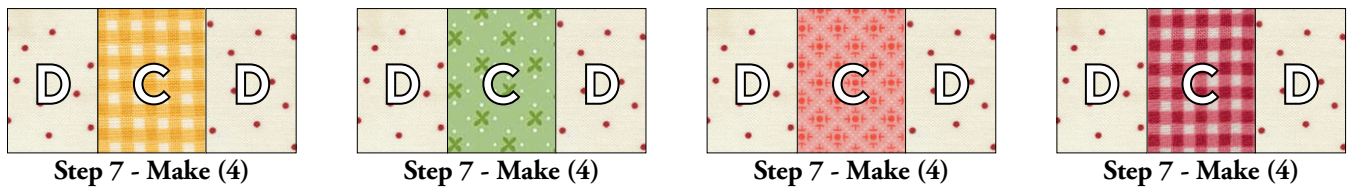
STEP 1: On the back of all "B" squares, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. **STEP 2:** Place a "B" square on the right side of an "A" rectangle, RST, noting the direction of the diagonal. **STEP 3:** Sew on the drawn line, and trim seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press toward "A". **STEP 4:** Place a "B" square on the left side of the "A" rectangle, RST, noting the direction of the diagonal. **STEP 5:** Sew on the drawn line, and trim seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press toward "A".



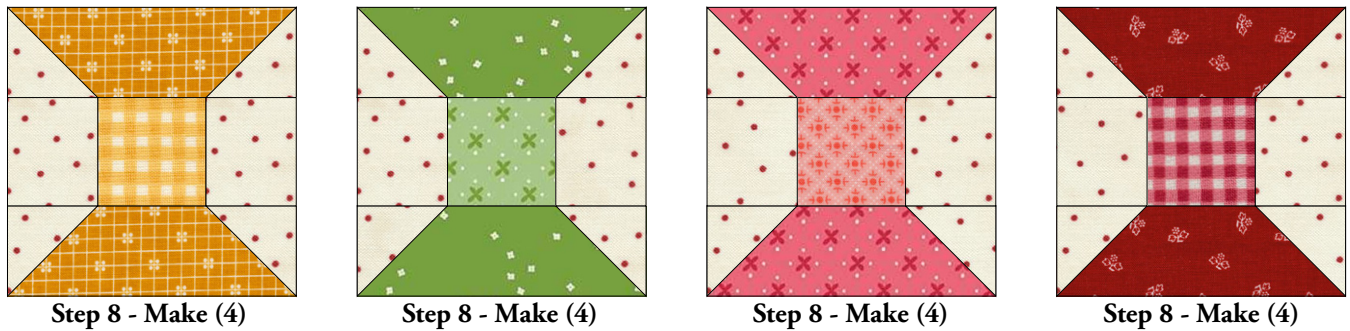
STEP 6: Repeat Steps 1-5 to make a total of (32) spool ends (8 *each* of four dark colors). Each spool end should measure $1\frac{1}{2}$ " \times 4".



STEP 7: Sew a "D" rectangle to the left and right sides of a "C" square. Press toward "D". Repeat to make a total of (16) spool centers (4 *each* of four light colors). Each spool center should measure 2" \times 4".

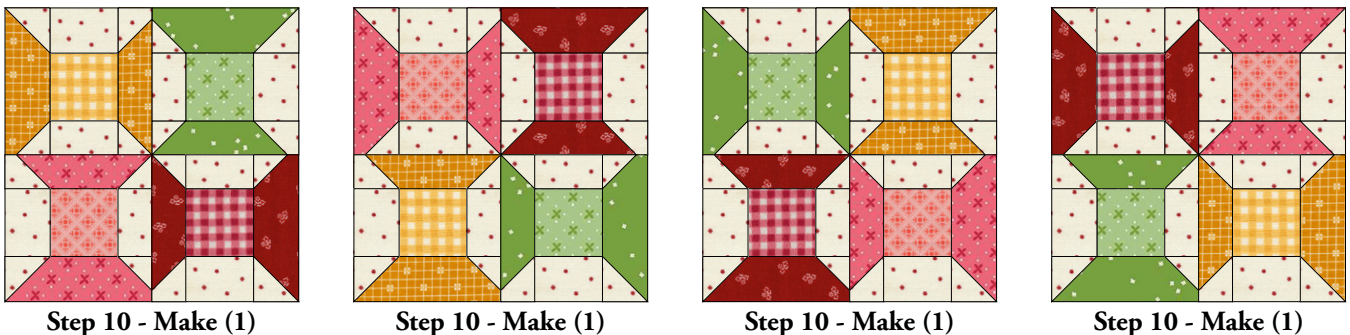


STEP 8: Sew a spool end to the top and bottom of a coordinating spool center, noting the orientation of the spool ends. Press open. Repeat to make a total of (16) spool units (4 *each* of four colors).



STEP 9: IMPORTANT: Trim each spool unit to $3\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".

STEP 10: Refer to diagrams below to arrange (4) spool blocks. Sew units together in rows; press open. Sew rows together; press open. Each block should measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".



APPLIQUÉ

NOTE: For the sample project, the "Apple" letters were cut away from the label with a laser cutting machine, allowing the fabric from the shape behind to provide the colors for the letters. If you have not purchased our laser-cut kit, you may opt to embroidery the "Apple" letters. Whatever method you choose, the letters should be created at this point.

NOTE: With the exception of the jar lid and bow, the appliqué design is symmetrical, so there is no need for a reverse diagram when tracing shapes for fusible appliqué. (*Reversed jar lid and bow shapes are provided for tracing.*)

Gently peel fusible paper from the back of each shape. Refer to Assembly Diagram to arrange shapes on **background** fabric.

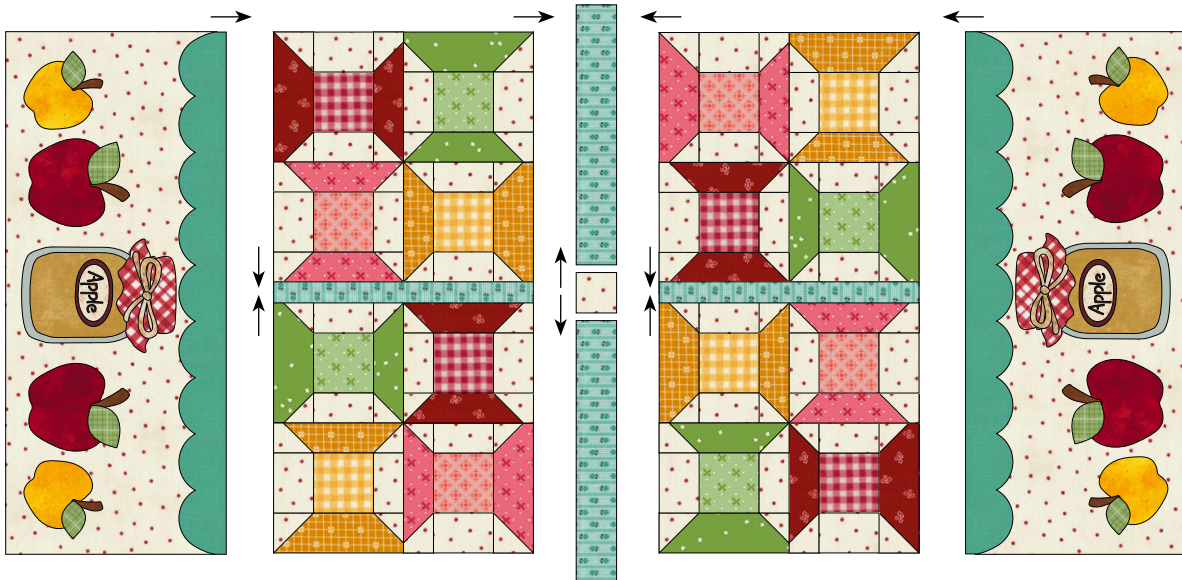
Appliqué in place using the method and stitch of your choice.



Appliqué - Make (2)

ASSEMBLE TABLE RUNNER

Arrange blocks as shown. Sew **sashing** strip between two blocks; press toward sashing. Sew sashing strips to each side of **cornerstone**; press toward sashing. Sew pieced blocks and sashing unit together; press toward sashing unit. Sew one appliqué unit to each end as shown; press toward pieced blocks.



FINISH TABLE RUNNER

Layer top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired.

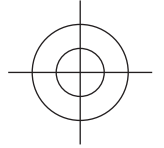
Piece **binding** into one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise, wrong sides together, and press. Line up raw edges of the binding with the raw edge of the table runner. Sew binding to the front side of the table runner, starting at any side. Turn the binding over and hand stitch to the back of the table runner.

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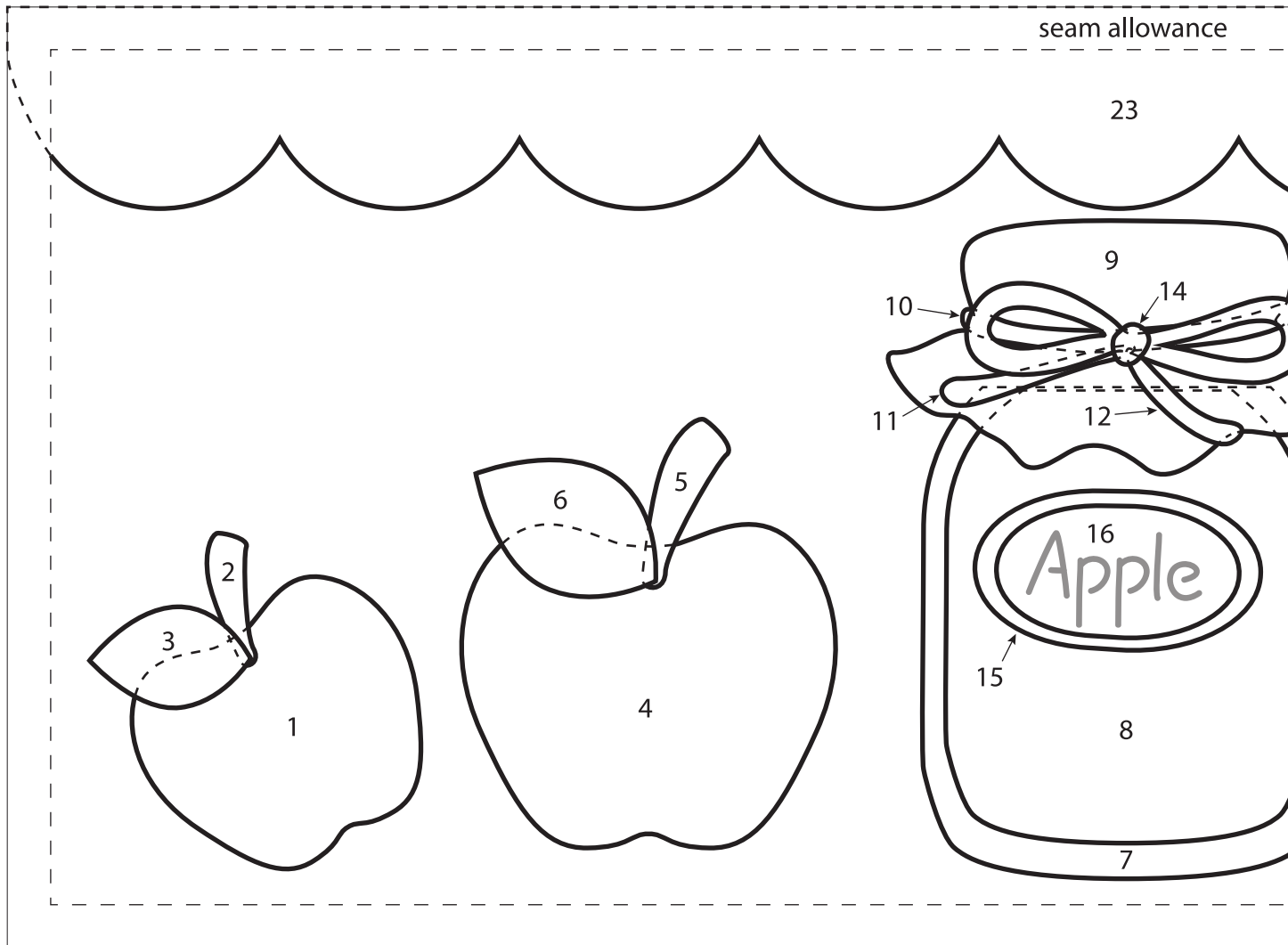
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Assembly Diagram

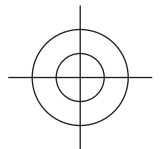
With the exception of the jar lid (9) and bow (10-14),

diagram can be used for tracing and for placement

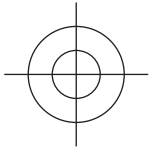
Align bullseye marks ⊕ on page 1 with

pages together



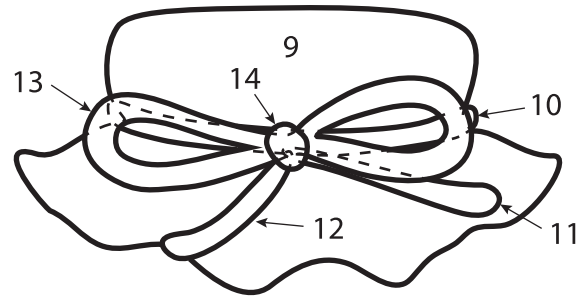
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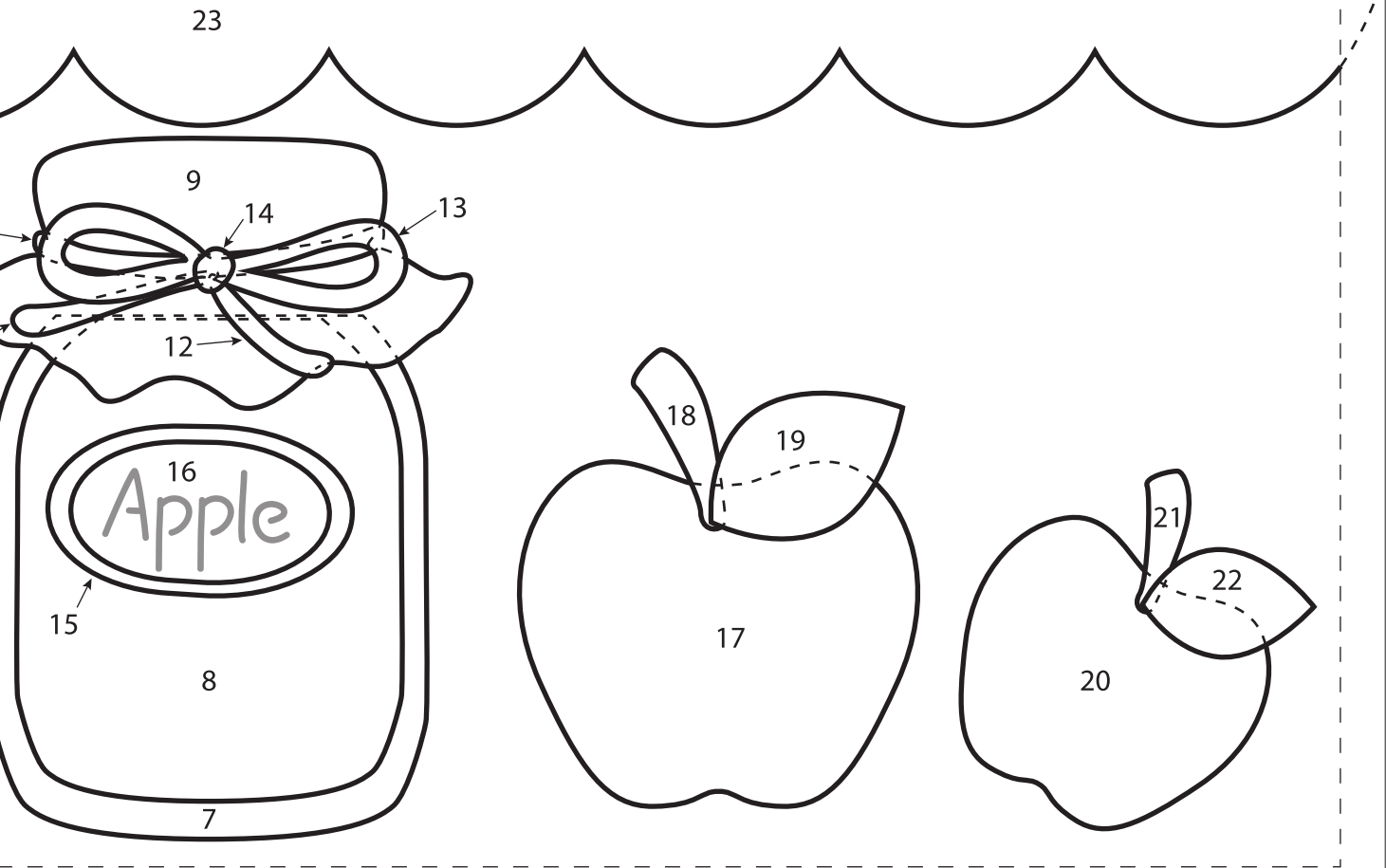




jar lid and bow
