






Fabric requirements and cutting

Large 108*108 King

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
Background Gray	6 yd	<p>Cut 5) 9 ¼" strip into 18) 9 ¼" square Cut twice on the diagonal  Place 36 in clue 2 baggie & 36 in clue 5 baggie</p> <p>Cut 5) 4 7/8" strips cut 36) 4 7/8" squares Cut once on the diagonal  Place in clue 5 baggie</p> <p>Cut 7) 4 7/8" strip into 54) 4 7/8" squares DRAW one diagonal line on the wrong side  Place in clue 1 baggie</p> <p>Cut 8) 4 ½" strips into 72) 4 ½" squares Place in clue 4 baggie</p> <p>Cut 9) 4 ½" strips into 36) 4 ½" x 8 ½" rectangles Place in clue 3 baggie</p> <p>Cut 10) 2 ½" strips for inner border Place in clue 7 baggie</p>
Medium blue	1 1/3 yd	<p>Cut 9) 4 7/8" strips into 18) 4 7/8" squares Place in clue 1 baggie</p> <p>Using the remaining strips cut 54) 4 7/8" squares Cut once on the diagonal  Place in clue 2 baggie</p>
Medium green	¾ yd	<p>Cut 5) 4 7/8" strip into 36) 4 7/8" squares Place in clue 1 baggie</p>
Dark Blue	3 7/8 yd	<p>Cut 9) 8 7/8" strip into 36) 8 7/8" squares Cut once on the diagonal  Place in clue 5 baggie</p> <p>Cut 2) 6 1/8" strip into 9) 6 1/8" square Place in clue 2 baggie</p> <p>Cut 10) 4 ½" strips for outer border Place in clue 7 baggie</p>

All yardage requirements are for 42" useable width fabrics

I strongly suggest pressing your fabric with starch before cutting.
